SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

[...] Here is my servant whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom my soul delights. I have endowed him with my spirit that he may bring true justice to the nations. He does not cry or shout aloud, or make his voice heard in the streets' [...] 'faithfully he brings true justice; [...] I, the lord, have called you to serve the cause of right; I have taken you by the hand and formed you; (Is. 42:1-4,6-7) The servant alludes to Jesus some centuries later. His mission to covenant of the people and light of the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to free captives from prison, and those who live in darkness from the dungeon. CAFOD, MISSIO and Sons of Divine Providence all ask for volunteers to be Jesus for the people today, sharing their innate goodness, love, gifts and talents. In his poverty, the baby Jesus speaks from the crib; the adult Jesus still suffers today and speaks through our personal suffering and through our suffering calls us to aid others who suffer. The NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION – to be Jesus for others – what is Jesus asking of me in 2023?

POPE EMERITUS BENEDICT XVI RIP Following the funeral on Thursday in the Vatican, ss parish and as Sons of Divine Providence we continue to pray for his eternal rest and in thanksgiving for Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI life, service in priesthood and Petrine ministry. At judgement, God will merciful to all of us –" have mercy upon me a sinner." He will also reward our love, our goodness and our efforts.

CARDINAL VINCENT NICHOLS, SPEAKING SHORTLY AFTER THE REQUIEM MASS IN ST PETER'S SQUARE FOR POPE EMERITUS BENEDICT XVI, described the funeral as in one way "a straightforward celebration of a Funeral Mass," in another way, a uniquely historical event "of great emotional depth and stature."

The Requiem Mass, presided over by Benedict's successor Pope Francis, took place on Thursday morning, 5 January, after almost 200,000 pilgrims had paid their final respects to the Pope Emeritus during a period of his lying in state for the previous three days.

Cardinal Nichols said he was collecting his memories of Pope Benedict during the Mass and considered his last homily before retiring. In it, Benedict used the image of Jesus asleep in the back of the boat in the storm on the Sea of Galilee and the disciples were frightened.
