OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST KING OF THE UNIVERSE

PSALTER WEEK II

'When the Son of Man comes in his glory, escorted by the angels, [...] All the nations will be assembled before him and he will separate men one from another as the shepherd separates sheep from goats. He will place the sheep on his right hand ...' (Matt 25:31-46); The prophet Ezechiel speaks of bad and selfish shepherds. Jesus has come as the Good Shepherd. Whether we are priests or parents, or siblings, we are called to give witness to God's love for humanity and share his love as best we can through our God-given resources. The last week of the liturgical year speaks of the final judgement. Jesus is our King and shepherd. He loves us, cares for us and leads us safely through this life towards and into heaven. The Cross accompanies us, and our good works go ahead of us. If we are sinners – turn around, change our ways and follow a new path: the virtuous enter eternal life, seated on the right hand of the Father. Pray for all the nations from around the world that God's salvation, love and mercy may reign with light, peace, joy, hope and justice.
