#### SCRIPTURE REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

'Who do people say the Son of Man is?' [...] 'But you,' he said 'who do you say I am?' Simon Peter spoke up, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.' [...] 'Happy are you' [...] 'My Father in heaven revealed this to you.' [...] 'You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church.' [...] I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven. [...] (Matt 16:13-19) Peter was chosen as Jesus' first successor. Peter was not perfect but he was called and chosen. None of the Popes were or claim to be perfect but they lead humanity on the road to heaven. We are shepherded, led, guided, fed and protected by Peter. In turn we must be shepherds. St. Paul, the other stalwart of the Church – thank God for these two great saints. Read their writings in the bible – be guided by them. Be holy.
