SCRIPTURE REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY 18TH AUGUST

Wisdom has built herself a house [...] she has prepared her wine, she has laid her table. [...] To the fool she says 'Come and eat my bread, drink the wine I have prepared! Leave your folly and you will walk in the ways of perception (Proverbs 9:1-6) St. Paul continues to tell us: live according to God's will and to be careful about the way we live – be transformed and continually change. Pray, sing psalms – inward/outwardly, the words speak to us of all aspects of our life, leading us to the God of goodness, love, & mercy. Jesus continues his teaching, that he is the bread come down from heaven, food for life and if we eat his body which is real flesh, we will have eternal life. We who eat his flesh and drink his blood live in him and he in us. Enter into silence during the holidays; reflect, meditate, contemplate: Jesus is drawing us into relationship with him. BUILDING WORKS UPDATE AND FUNDRAISING EVENTS Building works start Monday. There will be direct access into the hall through a temporary wheelchair-accessible new entrance. Flower bed has been saved. Scaffolding will cover the entire roof to enable simultaneous roof and ceiling replacement. Hoardings will be erected with some advertising inviting passers-by to donate to the building works. A Spanish slate has been selected, guaranteed for 100 years. Boilers fitted and commissioned; Rads working well.

Replace garden decking when scaffolding gone.
