

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

The word of God is something alive and active: it cuts more finely than any double-edged sword: it can slip through the place where the soul is divided from the spirit. [...] Everything is uncovered and opened to the eyes of the one to whom we must give account of ourselves ... (Mark 10:2-12) Clergy are asked to get feedback from parishioners on their homily. Long time ago, when in Dublin, the Jesuits taught us using PCT: Homily content includes Priest – sharing something of himself; Congregation – connect with them according to age /situation; Text – base the homily on the text of the day. We must read the scriptural text/s, meditate, pray, contemplate and ask God how is the word speaking to me & to the people through me? We will discover God's will, not mine / yours ...
