SCRIPTURE REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

'[...] so you also, when you have done all that you were commanded, say "We are unworthy servants; we have only done what was our duty." (Luke 17:5-10). CARDINAL JOINS CHURCH LEADERS IN CALLING FOR AN END TO THE WAR IN GAZA: Cardinal Vincent Nichols has joined Archbishop Stephen Cottrell, the Archbishop of York, and other Church leaders in calling for an end to the war in Gaza and the release of all hostages and prisoners after Israel launched its major ground offensive in Gaza City. In the joint statement, the Church leaders insist that "this deadly escalation is futile and must stop", urging the international community to ensure that Israel upholds its legal responsibility to protect civilians.
