SCRIPTURE REFLECTION FOR SUNDAY

The Lord said to me, 'You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will be glorified.' [...] he who formed me in the womb to be his servant [...], for I am honoured in the eyes of the Lord, and my God has become my strength – he says: 'It is too light a thing that you should be my servant [...] I will make you as a light for the nations that my salvation may reach the ends of the earth.' (Is 49:3; 5-6). The Magi were led to the crib, drawn by the light of a star. They encountered the Light, Peace and Salvation of the world. The accounts of Jesus' baptism tell he received the Holy Spirit. On this Sunday of Christian Unity Week, let us pray together that, starting in Teddington, may we share the Spirit of Light, Peace, Hope and Joy to the ends of the world. May God be our strength guided by the Spirit.
